0830 बजे ।ST पर दुर्ज की गई टिप्पणियों का सारांश/Summary of observations recorded at 0830 hours IST:

Southwest monsoon was normal over Coastal Karnataka & South Interior Karnataka and weak over North Interior Karnataka. Rainfall occurred at most places over Coastal Karnataka, and at a few places over South Interior Karnataka and at one or two places over North Interior Karnataka.

Synoptic Meteorological Feature:

- ❖ The Northern Limit of Monsoon continues to pass through 17.0°N/55°E, 17.5°N/60°E, 18°N/65°E, 18.5°N/70°E, Mumbai, Ahilyanagar, Adilabad, Bhawanipatna, Puri, Sandhead Island, 23.5°N/89.5°E, Balurghat, 30°N/85°E.
- A north-south trough runs roughly along Long. 87°E to the north of Lat. 22°N at 3.1 km above mean sea level.
- **❖** The north-south trough roughly along Long. 92°E to the north of Lat. 22°N at 1.5 km above mean sea level has moved away.



Impact expected:

- Visibility may become poor due to intense spell of rainfall leading to traffic congestion.
- Temporary Disruption of traffic due to water logging in roads/ uprooting of trees/ breaking of tree branches leading to increased travel time.
- Uprooting of trees may cause damages to power sector
- Possibility of damages to vulnerable structures due to heavy to very heavy rainfall
- Partial Damages to Kutcha Houses and Huts due to uprooting of trees.
- Possibilities of Flash floods due to intense spell of rainfall.
- Water logging / flooding in many parts of low-lying areas.
- Landslides/mud slide/land slip very likely over Coast and ghat areas.
- Heavy rainfall may damage the standing crops and vegetables in the maturity stage.
- Lightning may injure people and cattle at open place.

Action suggested:

- Follow traffic advisories issued, if any.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.
- Avoid going to the areas that face water logging problems/ river fronts.
- People in the vulnerable area are advised to move to safer places.
- Take shelter during thunderstorm/lightning activities.
- Avoid working in the fields during thunderstorm/lightning period and ensure proper mechanism to avoid runoff in case of rain.
- Be Updated.

Weather Outlook for subsequent 3 days (During 11th June – 13th June, 2025):

Rainfall likely to occur at many places over Karnataka.

<u>Fishermen warning:</u>. Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevailing over Karnataka Coast.

Fishermen advised not to venture into the sea
